

Attachments for Order Pickers

Order preparation operation or likewise called order picking as it is more normally known is a method utilized within warehouse operations and consists of employees known as order pickers. The order picker's job is to collect and take articles in particular quantities so as to fulfill the client's orders prior to shipment. Order picking is a simple warehousing process. The effectiveness in which this job is accomplished can be directly related to the productivity of a supply chain. Therefore, order picking is one of the most controlled logistic processes. Order picking falls within the category of the warehouse management system.

There are several particular kinds of order picking. The main types consist of: pick to box method, wave picking method, piece picking or picker to part method, zone picking method and sorting systems method.

The pick to box method involves the order picker just filling the boxes with things that are from their particular station. The box then moves on to other stations until the order is complete. In this method, there is no movement of the order picker personnel. In the wave picking method, the order pickers move round so as to collect the needed things for some orders. The piece picking or picker to part method is similar where the order pickers or picker move to gather the items required but for one order only.

There is no movement by the order picker in the sorting systems method. Rather, things are brought to the order picker by an automatic system like for instance an automatic storage system or a conveyor system. In the zone picking method, every order picker is assigned to one particular zone. They are responsible for just realizing order picking within this particular area.
